Step 1	Step 2
 Wash boat thoroughly inside and out using a mixture of Simple Green and warm water. Use only clean sponges and brushes to wash the hulls. NEVER use SOS pads, steel wool Do NOT apply WD-40 or grease on the wheels or tracks. 	 Check hull, Skeg, Card Clip and bow ball for damage. Note any damage on the diagram below (add riggers for reference) and describe damage under remarks. Only if applicable: Boat Whitening Date Waxing Date ONLY USE WHITENING ON WHITE HULLED BOATS. NEVER ON THE RESOLUTEOR ANY OTHER COLORED BOATS
STERN	BOW
Place a check in each box after completing task Check foot stretchers for missing wing nuts, tie	
downs or other parts. Replace any missing hardware. Note any items that were not replaced or any repairs needed below.	
Check riggers for missing bolts, nuts, washers and spacers and replace any missing hardware. Every nut should have a washer underneath it. Note any items that were not replaced or any repairs needed below.	
Check steering cable to see if it is frayed and in danger of breaking.	Talk to coxswain to see if the speakers are working properly.
Check skeg to see if it looks straight.	Check bow ball, card clip and heel ties steering cable.
Impellers, stroke coach clips on singles.
