## Step 1

- Wash boat thoroughly inside and out using a mixture of Simple Green and warm water.
- Use only clean sponges and brushes to wash the hulls. NEVER use SOS pads, steel wool
- Do NOT apply WD-40 or grease on the wheels or tracks.

## Step 2

- Check hull, Skeg, Card Clip and bow ball for damage. Note any damage on the diagram below (add riggers for reference) and describe damage under remarks.

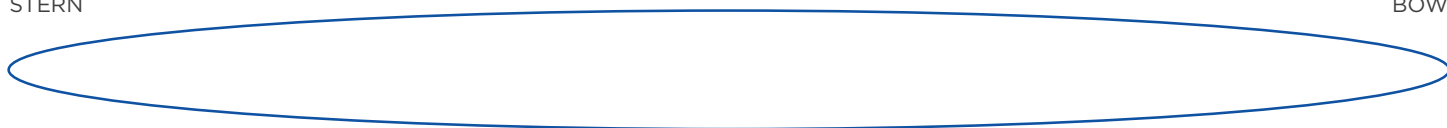

*Place a check in each box after completing task*

- ☐ Check **foot stretchers** for missing wing nuts, tie downs or other parts. Replace any missing hardware. **Note any items that were not replaced or any repairs needed below.**

- ☐ Check **riggers** for missing bolts, nuts, washers and spacers and replace any missing hardware. Every nut should have a washer underneath it. **Note any items that were not replaced or any repairs needed below.**

- ☐ Check steering cable to see if it is frayed and in danger of breaking.

- ☐ Check skeg to see if it looks straight.

- ☐ Impellers, stroke coach clips on singles.

- ☐ Talk to coxswain to see if the speakers are working properly.

- ☐ Check bow ball, card clip and heel ties steering cable.
